Learn what affordable Health care can do for <u>you</u> at a program sponsored by the Door County League of Women Voters! The forum will be Thursday, October 17, from 6:00-8:00 p.m. at Bay View Lutheran Church, 340 Maple Street, Sturgeon Bay.

This program will present an overview of the provisions in the Affordable Care Act and clarify how uninsured Wisconsin residents can access coverage through enrollment in Wisconsin's federally-facilitated Marketplace/Exchange or under the revised Medicaid/BadgerCare in Wisconsin. How area doctors, hospitals and clinics are managing the new guidelines under the ACA will also be presented, including the mandated coverage of essential benefits and free preventive services.
