ESTELLA LAUTER

Congratulations to LWV member Estella Lauter on her appointment as Door County Poet Laureate for 2013 – 2015 at the March 26 meeting of the Door County Board of Supervisors. The position was established in Oct. 2010; Francis May, honored posthumously, was selected as the first county poet laureate. Lauter follows Barbara Larsen of Sister Bay, the first living person to be appointed. Estella's published works include *The Essential Rudder: North Channel Poems* and *Pressing a Life Together by Hand*. Her work also appears regularly in editions of the *Wisconsin Poets' Calendar* and *Peninsula Pulse*. She is readying a manuscript for publication about Mexican visual artist Remedios Varo (1908-1963), *Transfigurations: Re-imagining Remedios Varo*, scheduled for release in August.
